

Competition Ages

The age group that you will swim at will depend upon the competition you are involved in. For instance, all Club competitions are age as at the 31st December of that year. So it doesn't matter if your birthday is in February or December.

National competitions also use age as at 31st December. So does the Friendly League.

The Micro League was going to use the same age criteria, but they are now defining the age as at the final gala of the year. For this year, that is as the 29th November. This means if you are 10 in July you will compete as a 10 year old, but if you are 10 in December, then you will compete as a 9 year old.

Also for external competitions the minimum age is 9 years old. You are not allowed to compete as an 8 year old unless it is a league competition.
