On Saturday, 9th May, two members of the Colne ASC Masters Team travelled to the John Charles Centre for Sport in Leeds for the Yorkshire SA Open Masters and Senior Age Groups 2015.

Daniel Dawson swimming in the 35 to 39 years age group finished 3rd in the 100m Freestyle, 4th in the 50m Breaststroke and 5th in the 50m Freestyle.

Philip Croxall swimming in the 45 to 49 years age group finished 2nd in the 50m Backstroke, 100m and 200m Individual Medley, 3rd in the 50m Butterfly, 4th in the 50m Breaststroke and 5th in the 50m Freestyle.

Sponsored Swim
