On Saturday, 23rd and Sunday, 24th January, a team of 7 swimmers from Colne ASC took part in the **Rotherham Metro A & B Grade Long Course Meet 2016** at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre in Sheffield. There were only **Maria Massey** and **Saskia Daly** who achieved A Grade times.

Maria Massey (11 years) finished 32nd in the A Grade 50m Freestyle, 9th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke, 18th in the B Grade 100m Freestyle, 19th in the B Grade 200m Freestyle, 24th in the B Grade 50m Breaststroke and 27th in the B Grade 100m Backstroke.

Saskia Daly (11 years) finished 33rd in the A Grade 50m Freestyle, 12th in the B Grade 200m Freestyle, 15th in the B Grade 50m Butterfly, 16th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke, 20th in the B Grade 100m Freestyle, 21st in the B Grade 50m Breaststroke and 31st in the B Grade 100m Breaststroke.

Mia Dodman (11 years) finished 4th in the B Grade 100m Freestyle, 5th in the B Grade 50m Freestyle, 8th in the B Grade 200m Freestyle, 10th in the B Grade 50m Butterfly, 14th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke and 16th in the B Grade 100m Backstroke.

Danielle Baxter (13 years) finished 5th in the B Grade 50m Freestyle, 7th in the B Grade 50m Breaststroke, 7th in the B Grade 100m Butterfly, 8th in the B Grade 50m Backstroke, 12th in the B Grade 100m Breaststroke, 12th in the B Grade 100m Freestyle and 13th in the B Grade 200m Freestyle.

Grace Root (10 years) 1st in the B Grade 50m Breaststroke and 4th in the B Grade 100m Breaststroke.

Carlisle Masters Meet

On Friday, 22nd and Saturday, 23rd January, a sole representative from the Colne ASC masters team took part in the Carlisle Aquatics Masters Meet 2016.

Tony Catterall who returned to competition this year, competed in the 70 to 74 years age group and took part in 13 events, in which he finished 1st in 11 of them and was second in the other two.

They were the 800m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley, 200m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke, 100m Individual Medley, 200m Breaststroke, 50m Backstroke, 200m Individual Medley, 200m Freestyle, 100m Backstroke and 50m Breaststroke. The other ones were the 50m and 100m Freestyle events.

Miranda finished 1st equal in the heats of the 100m Backstroke but ended up finishing 5th in the final.
