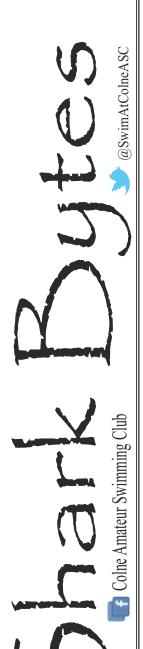

Harrogate Janus Meet 2018

On the first weekend of the year, three swimmers from Colne ASC travelled to Harrogate for the Harrogate District Swimming Clubs' Janus A/B Graded Meet 2018.

Amelia Redfern swimming in the 9 years age group in her first age group competition finished 4th in the B Graded 50m Freestyle and 3rd in the B Graded 50m Butterfly.

Saskia Daly swimming in the 13 years age group finished 6th in the B Graded 50m Breaststroke, 2nd in the B Graded 200m Freestyle, 3rd in the B Graded 50m Butterfly, 4th in the A Graded 100m Freestyle, 3rd in the A Graded 50m Freestyle and 9th in the B Graded 50m Backstroke.

Mia Dodman also swimming in the 13 years age group finished 8th in the A Graded 200m Freestyle, 5th in the A Graded 50m Butterfly, 1st in the B Graded 100m Freestyle, 2nd in the B Graded 50m Backstroke and 3rd in the B Graded 100m Backstroke.

Friendly League

The Annual General Meeting for the Friendly League should have taken place on Tuesday, 16th January, but was postponed due to adverse weather

The Club has put through two proposals for rule changes;

- 1. That Category Two swimmers be eligible to swim, but only if they have not achieved a Lancashire Qualifying Time for that stroke.
- 2. The age groups revert to the pre 2017 rule changes, namely, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14 and 15 and

Poolside Tidy Up

It would be appreciated that equipment is returned to the baskets once their lesson has completed.

If fins/flippers have been used, then they need to be rinsed under the showers and returned to the large basket.

Floats and pull-buoys need to be stacked neatly in the smaller basket, do not throw them into the basket. The floats should be stacked neatly at the side of the basket if a lot of floats have been used.

Teachers need to remind the children to return any equipment used to the baskets.

Water Bottles

Swimmers are encouraged to bring water bottles with them onto the poolside.

During exercise you will lose body fluids through sweating, so it is important that you replace these fluids and remain properly hydrated.

Water is one of the best fluids that you can use for training, and it can be flavoured with cordial. Do not use fizzy drinks as this will make you feel bloated.

Once your lesson has finished please remember to collect your water bottle and not leave it on the poolside.
