Financial AGM

The Financial Annual General Meeting will be to the adding of an extra age group. taking place on Wednesday, 21st March at the Pendle Leisure Centre. The meeting will be invited to attend, but neither turned up starting at 8pm.

All members are allowed to attend but it is only division of 5 teams; Colne, Accrington, fully paid up members over the age of 18 who Burnley, Darwen and Great Harwood. are allowed to vote.

The first was a change to allow category two swimmers back into the league, but with a stipulation that the swimmer has not achieved a Lancashire County qualifying time for that event and age group. There was a amendment proposed to split the league into a category one and two, but that was rejected.

The second proposal was to reintroduce the 2016 age groups of 9/10, 12 and under, 14 and under, and open. This was accepted with an amendment of a 16 years and under age group.

The two mixed medley relays of 13 and under and open were kept unchanged, but the 8 x 25m canon relay was extended to a 10 x 25m canon relay due

Both Pioneer 79 and Ramsbottom were so the league was kept as a single

your child's swimming lesson has finished and they are off the pool side. Colne Swimming Club is no clubmark longer responsible for their welfare.




