### Club Championship Gala 2018

The 2018 edition of the Colne ASC Annual Club Championship Gala was held on Monday, 19th and Thursday, 22nd November at the Pendle Leisure Centre.

There was only one record broken over the two nights, and that was by Charlotte Leigh in the Girls SC Taylor Shield 11 years and over 100m Breaststroke. She lowered the time by nearly 4 seconds to 1 minute 22.87 seconds, beating her sister Rachel's time from 2016.

Over the two nights there were 20 different winners of the 48 trophies on offer, with Jack Nevison the big winner as he won 9 (yes nine) events. It would have been 10, if not for an incorrect stroke in the 200m Individual Medley.

The other big winners were Charlotte Leigh who won 5 events and Jack Middleton who won 4 events. There were 4 swimmers who won a trio of events and they were Caitlin Harper, Eleanor Fuggle, Ermita Balnyte and Lewis Fenwick.

Winning two events apiece were Amelia Redfearn, James Henderson, Matilda Critchley, Ruairi Sweeney and Saskia Daly.

The final eight trophy winners who won a single event were Alicia Higginbottom, Charlie Pomfret, Eden Hughes, George Collins, Kian Noon, Lily Hutchinson, Luke Chew and Mia Dodman.

The trophies will be presented to the winners at the Club's Annual Presentation on Saturday, 15th December. Also named will be the winner of the Spot-On Competition and the top prize of £20.



### **Betty Petty Style Trophy**

The **Betty Petty Style Trophy** was held the week before the main Club Championship Galas, on Monday, 12th and Thursday, 15th November.

There were a total of 34 swimmers being assessed, which was split evenly between 17 boys and 17 girls.

Each swimmer was assessed over two lengths for backstroke, breaststroke and frontcrawl. They had to demonstrate the start, stroke, turn and finish for each of the three strokes.

The assessment was carried out by teacher Mark Ennis.

The results for the 34 swimmers will be announced at the Annual Presentation on Saturday, 15th December at the Nelson Cricket Club.

# **Swim England Masters Championships 2018**

On the weekend of Friday, 26th to Sunday, 28th October there were over 1200 athletes that descended upon Sheffield for the Swim England National Masters Championships 2018, being held at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre.

Amongst them was Colne ASC masters swimmer Philip Croxall, who was competing in the 45 to 49 years age group for the last time. He participated in five events over the weekend attaining season's bests in all five.

On the Friday he took part on the 200m Individual Medley where he finished 12th in 2:45.07.

On the Saturday he took part in three events with 15th place in the 100m Individual Medley in a time of 1:14.57. He followed this with a 7th place in the 200m Freestyle in 2:21.25, his best time for over 2 years. The final event of the day was the 200m Breaststroke where he finished 8th in a time of 2:57.84.

His final event was the 100m Breaststroke on Sunday morning where he finished 14th in a time of 1:19.10, which was his best for 2 years.
