# Northern Counties Long Course Open Championship

On the weekend of the 26th/27th November, 2 Colne ASC swimmers competed at the Northern Counties Long Course Open Championships which were held at the Manchester Aquatics Centre. Both were successful in the Junior Age Group.

William Harrison (16) reached 3 finals: 2nd in 50m Freestyle (7th overall), 4th in 50m Backstroke (7th overall) and 2nd in 50m Butterfly (4th overall).

He also finished 14th in 100m Butterfly (26th overall) and 15th in 100m Freestyle (27th overall).

Joshua Finch (15) reached 1 final: 3rd in 50m Butterfly (7th overall) a new personal best.

He also finished 9th in 100m Butterfly (19th overall) a new personal best, 18th in 50m Freestyle (34th overall) a new personal best and 25th in 100m Breaststroke (39th overall) a new personal best.
