### ASA National Masters & Senior Age Group Championships 2007

From Friday, 26th till Sunday, 28th October it was the ASA National Masters & Senior Age Group Championships 2007 held at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre, Sheffield. Two member of the Colne ASC Masters Team took part, they were Stephen Smith and Philip Croxall, both swimming in the 35 to 39 years age group.

On the Friday, it was Philip swimming in the 100m Breaststroke, in which he finished 10th place in a time of 1 min 14.90 seconds, which was a new lifetime personal best by 1.2 seconds.

On the Saturday, Philip finished 7th in the 400m Freestyle with a time of 4 min 56.00 seconds, and then in the afternoon he finished 6th in the 200m Breaststroke with a time of 2 min 45.43 seconds, which was a personal best by 4.5 seconds.

Next up was Stephen who finished 2nd in the 100m Freestyle in a time of 55.01 seconds, losing out by 0.04 of a second!.

On the Sunday Philip finished 6th in the 50m Breaststroke with a time of 34.11 which was the best he has done for 19 years. He then finished 14th in the 50m Freestyle with a time of 27.24 which was also a new personal best, but he lost out to Stephen who powered to 4th place with a time of 25.44 seconds.

### **Betty Petty Style Trophy**

This years Betty Petty Style Trophy will be held on Saturday, 17th November. The event will start at 6:00pm until 8:00pm, with the swimmers being judged upon their starts, turns and style for backstroke, breaststroke and frontcrawl.

This competition is open to all swimmers aged 15 years or under, except previous winners who are not allowed to take part.

#### **Christmas Sprint Gala**

This years sprint gala will take place on Thursday, 6th December. Warm-up at 6:45pm with the competition starting at 7:00pm. This is open to all member of the Club and there is even a race for teachers and parents. Everybody will only swim a maximum of 25 metres for all of the four strokes.

# **Teachers Meeting**

At the recent teacher's meeting it was stressed that ALL swimmers must wear a swimming cap during lessons.

Any swimmer arriving for their lesson more than 5 minutes late will not be allowed in the water.

Water bottles must be collected from the pool side at the end of the lesson.

It is recommended that ALL swimmers have water bottles to reduce the risk of dehydration.



The 'Spot-On' Competition is open to ALL members of the Club, yes that does include parents and teachers.

The aim is to get as close as possible to your submitted time.

For instance if you submit 40 seconds for the two lengths and then swim the distance in 38.64 seconds, you would be 1.36 seconds off target.

This event will take place on Thursday, 22nd November in the middle of the second Championship Gala.

It only costs £1 to enter, so have a go, you never know you may beat your child and win the £20 first prize.

### **Championships Galas**

This years Championships Gala will take place on the Thursdays of 15th and 22nd November.

The warm-up starts at 6:45pm on each night, with the competition starting at 7:00pm.

The events are open to all swimmers who have been a member since 1st July and have at least 50% attendence. If you don't meet the criteria then you will be allowed to swim for times only.

Other successful swims included: Jack Workman (15yrs) achieving a 2nd place in 200m Individual Medley a new personal best; and Lewis Fox (16yrs/over) achieving a 2nd place in 200m Individual Medley. All three swimmers attained Lancashire Qualifying Times.

**Charlotte Beech** (13yrs) was the only other swimmer to attain the Lancashire Qualifying Time finishing 7th in 50m Freestyle in a personal best time.
