

Championship Galas

A total of 8 new records were set over the course of the two nights. At first Championship Gala there were 5 new records set.

- Ashleigh Dibb** in the Bramhill Cup - 25m Backstroke 10 and under.
- Ashleigh Dibb** in the Dot Hartley Trophy - 100m Individual Medley 10 and under.
- Laura Foulkes** in the Presidents Cup - 50m Frontcrawl 16 and over.
- Joshua Finch** in the Corteen Cup - 100m Individual Medley 16 and over.
- Jack Coyne** in the Harry Dewhurst Trophy - 100m Individual Medley 10 and under.

A further 3 records were set in the 2nd Championship Gala.

- Ashleigh Dibb** in the Woodthorpe White Trophy - 25m Breaststroke 10 and under.
- Laura Foulkes** in the Senior Championship Trophy - 200m Freestyle Open age.
- Christian Butschok-Brain** in the Wilkinson Trophy - 25m Frontcrawl 8 and under.

During the course of the second Championship Gala, the Spot-On competition was held. This allowed some of the parents to compete against their children, as the aim was to get as close as you could to your submitted time.

In third place was Bethany Gribble, who received 5 for getting within 0.32 seconds of her submitted time.

In second place was Sharon Titterton, who received 10 for getting within 0.29 seconds of her submitted time, much to the annoyance of her daughters Charlotte and Samantha.

In first place was Ainsley Dibb, who received 20 for matching exactly her submitted time. She said she would take 36.00 seconds and she took exactly 36.00 seconds.

In all there were 23 entrants with the biggest margin being only 10 seconds off their submitted time. With the first 9 getting within a second of their submitted time.
