Friendly League

On Thursday, 6th March, we played hosts to Ramsbottom in our first fixture of the new Friendly League Season. The Colne swimmers started off strongly winning the 14 of the first 20 races, and then finished even stronger by winning 17 of the remaining 20 races, leaving the final result as a convincing 71 points to 49 victory.

There were 19 new personal bests set by the Colne swimmers. Our next fixture is at home on 27th March to the current champions Pioneer '79.

Lancashire County Age Groups

On the 8-9th March weekend, Colne ASC had 7 swimmers competing at the Lancashire County Championships & Age **Groups** (Manchester Aquatics), Sessions No.1 to 4. A total of 2 medals were achieved over the weekend with two 3rd places, reaching no fewer than 3 finals between them, 12 personal best times, with 3 ASA North West Region and 1 ASA National qualifying times.

Ashleigh Dibb competing for the very first time in a 50m pool, in the 9yr Age Group achieved a 5th place in the 50m Freestyle and a 4th place in the 200m Breaststroke, both in personal best

Morgan Hartley competing in the 11yr Age Group achieved a 15th place in the 200m Breaststroke, and a 27th place in the 200m Freestyle both in personal best times.

Charlotte Beech competing in the 13yr Age Group achieved a 16th place in the 50m Freestyle in a personal best time.

Laura Foulkes competing in the 16yr Age Group achieved a 11th place in the 50m Freestyle and a 7th place in the Final of the 100m Freestyle, in an ASA North West Youth qualifying time and personal best time.

Jack Workman competing in the 16yr Age Group achieved a 7th place in the final of the 100m Backstroke, a 3rd place in the 200m Backstroke and a 3rd place in the 200m Freestyle in personal best times, with the latter in an ASA North West Youth qualifying time.

Joshua Finch competing in the Open Age Group achieved a 4th place in the final of the 100m Butterfly in an ASA National qualifying time by 0.32 of a second.

Lewis Fox competing in the Open Age Group achieved 21st place overall in the 200m Freestyle in a personal best time.



If you find yourself travelling abroad and you wish to partake in a training session with a foreign club then you must arrange permission from the ASA at least 28 days before you travel, using the **International Permit and Clearance Form**.

This also applies if you wish to compete abroad in competition, but does not include swimming in a hotel pool whilst on holiday abroad. There are no fees applicable.

An **ASA Medical Declaration** form will also have to be filled in unless you are a Masters Swimmer.

Forms are available from Mrs Croxall or can be downloaded from the ASA website at http://www.britishswimming.org.

The Club Coach Andrew Croxall will also have to be informed as he is required to sign the form as part of the clearance procedure.
