Australia Bound

On Sunday, 13th April, two members of the Colne ASC Masters Team travelled to **Perth**, Australia to take part in the forthcoming XII FINA World Masters Championships 2008. The event will be held at the Challenge Stadium in Perth and takes place from 15th April until the 25th April. The events range from Swimming, Diving, Water Polo, Synchronized Swimming and Open Water Swimming.



Karen Driver will be competing in the 35 to 39 years age group.

Her first event will take place on Friday, 18th April where she will be competing in the 800m Freestyle. On Thursday, 24th April will see her take part in the 400m Freestyle and then on the following day she will take part in the 3km Open Water Swim. This is Karen's first competition at a World Masters.

Philip Croxall will also be competing in the 35 to 39 years age. His first event will take place on Saturday, 19th April where he will be competing in the **100m Breaststroke**. His second and last event will be the 200m Breaststroke on Wednesday, 23rd April - St George's Day!. This will be Philip's third World Masters, as he took part previously in New Zealand in 2002 and Italy in 2004.

Starts and Turns Workshop

On Saturday, 10th May there will be a starts and turns workshop run by coach Dave Crouch. This session is aimed at all the Friendly League and Micro League team swimmers, but is open to other swimmers.
