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North Lancashire Age Groups

On the 24-25th January & 31st January-1st February weekends, we had 7 swimmers competing at the **North Lancashire Prelim Age Groups** at the **Palatine Pool** in Blackpool. A total of 6 medals were achieved over both weekends with five 2nd and one 3rd place, 10 Lancashire qualifying times and 32 personal best times.

The outstanding swimmers were in the 10 year girls Age Group with **Ashleigh Dibb** achieving three 2nd places in 50m Backstroke, 50m Butterfly and 100m Individual Medley and a 3rd place in 200m Backstroke, and **Samantha Titterton** achieving two 2nd places in 50m and 200m Breaststroke. Ashleigh also set a new personal best in 50m Freestyle. Samantha also set new personal bests in 50m Freestyle, 100m Individual Medley, 400m Freestyle, 50m Butterfly, 50m Backstroke and 200m Backstroke.

The other swimmers competing were **Ainsley Dibb** (13) who set personal bests in 100m Backstroke and 200m Individual Medley, **Morgan Hartley** (12) setting new bests in 100m Breaststroke, 100m Freestyle, 200m Freestyle and 800m Freestyle, **Olivia Pratt** (11) setting new bests in 200m Freestyle, 400m Freestyle, 100m Breaststroke, 200m Individual Medley and 100m Freestyle, **Charlotte Titterton** (12) setting new bests in 400m Freestyle, 800m Freestyle, 100m Breaststroke, 200m Breaststroke, 100m Freestyle and 200m Freestyle, 100m Breaststroke, 200m Breaststroke, 100m Freestyle and 200m Freestyle and **Jack Coyne** (11) who set a new best for 100m Breaststroke.
