At the British Gas ASA National Youth Championships and British Gas National Championships 2009 held at the Ponds Forge International Sports Centre in Sheffield, 20 year old William Harrison took on the best swimmers in the country. The Colne swimmer was representing Bournemouth at the championships.

In the heats of the 50m Freestyle he finished equal 10th place in a time of 23.50 seconds, in the final he upped the pace to finish in 7th place with an improved time of 23.44. Of the British swimmers in the final he was 3rd.

In the 50m Butterfly he finished 9th in the heats with a time of 25.49 which qualified him for the final where he finished 7th in a time of 25.23 seconds. This was a new personal best time for William.

Jacob's Triathlon Challenge

Jacob Kalan has taken up a new challenge of triathlons.

Throughout the year he has done four events with his best being a 3rd place finish in the 13/14 year boys tristar 3.

He also competed in the open water event at the Salford Quays where he finished 5th in his age group and 11th overall in the 500m Novice Race.
