Yorkshire Masters Championships

On Saturday, 14th May, four members of the Colne ASC Masters Team travelled to the North Bay Indoor Pool in Scarborough for the Yorkshire Open Masters Championships 2011, and between them they won 6 golds, 6 silvers and 6 bronze medals.

Swimming in the 40 to 44 years age group was **Stephen Smith** who won the 100m Freestyle and the 100m Individual Medley. He also finished 2nd in the 200m Individual Medley and the 50m Freestyle.

Also in the the 40 to 44 years age group was Karen Driver who won the 200m Individual Medley and 200m Freestyle events. She also finished 2nd in the 50m Breaststroke and the 100m Breaststroke, and was 4th in the 100m Freestyle and the 100m Individual Medley.

Philip Croxall swimming in the 40 to 44 years age group wins the 100m Backstroke. He finishes 2nd in the 100m Breaststroke, and 3rd in the 200m Individual Medley, the 100m Freestyle, the 200m Freestyle and the 100m Individual Medley.

John Penswick swimming in the 70 to 74 years age group wins the 100m Breaststroke. He is 2nd in the 50m Breaststroke, and is 3rd in the 50m Backstroke and the 50m Freestyle.

Age Group Gala - Most Improved Swimmer
