ASA NWR Masters Distance Meet

Four members of the Colne ASC Masters team travelled to the Palatine Leisure Centre in Blackpool for the ASA North West Region Distance Meet on Saturday, 25th February.

Competing were John Penswick who was swimming in the 70 to 74 years age group, and Karen Driver, Stephen Smith and Philip Croxall who were all swimming in the 40 to 44 years age group. New for this year was an overall winner using an age adjusted time to determine the winner.

Karen was in fine form as she won the 1500m Freestyle and 800m Freestyle events with the 1500 in a new personal best time. She was also the overall womens 1500m champion and was 2nd in the 800m, and set new 40 to 44 Regional Records for both events.

Philip finished 1st in the 800m Freestyle and 4th in the 400m Freestyle events. This gave him an overall position of 7th in the 800 and 8th in the 400.

Stephen finished 2nd in the 800m Freestyle and 3rd in the 400m Freestyle. This gave him an overall position of 6th in the 400 and 9th in the 800.

John finished 3rd in the 1500m Freestyle, which gave him an overall position of 21st.
